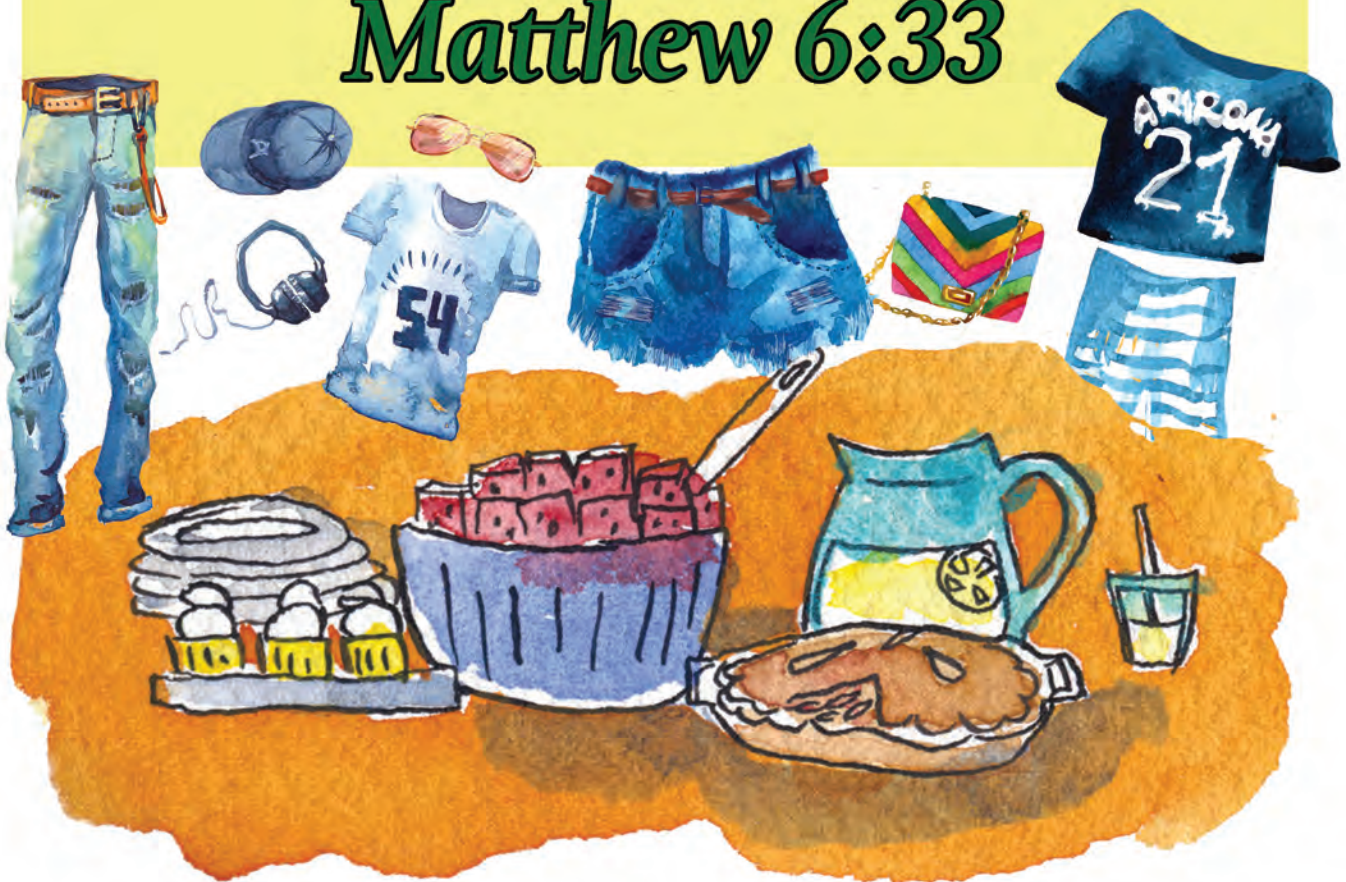

# LESSON 1

## Craft: Let's Make a Scroll

*This is the kind of book people had in the Bible times.*

**Matthew 4:4**

**It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.**

**You will need:**

**Paper** for the scroll: use white printing paper 8.5 x 11 and glue end to end **or** purchase a roll of butcher or craft paper and cut to size.

**Glue**

**2 Paper towel sized tubes** per scroll

**Printed out verses** either to copy or cut and glue to paper scroll.

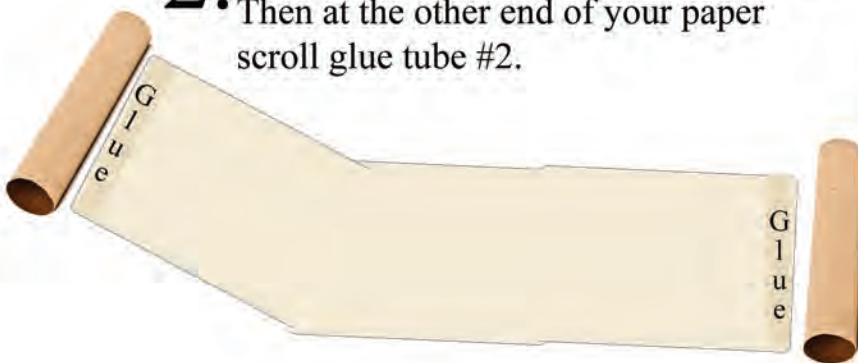
**Time to complete: 10-15 minutes**



1. Glue paper end to end if you are using individual sheets of printing paper or cut your rolled paper to size.



2. Glue paper end to paper towel tube #1. Then at the other end of your paper scroll glue tube #2.



3. Take the verses you printed out and cut them out and glue them into your scroll. You may also simply write out your favorite verses. Give the glue a few minutes to dry before you roll it up! Now you have a book from biblical times!

# LESSON 3

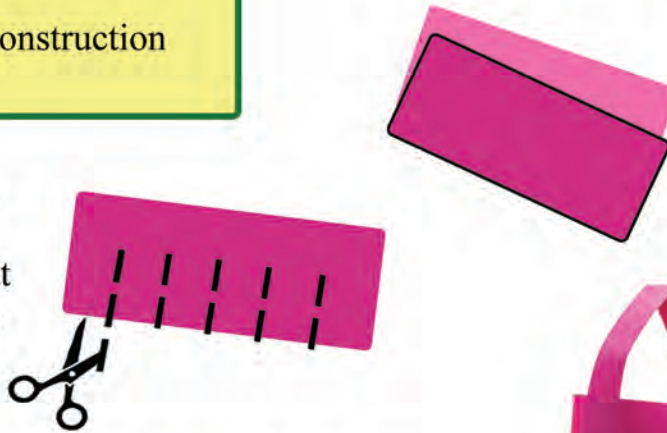
## God's Word is a Light unto my Path Let's make a Paper Lantern

### You will need:

Scissors, Scotch Tape, glue, markers or crayons (to decorate) and 2- 8.5 x 11 pieces of construction paper or cardstock

1. Fold one of the sheets of paper in half longwise

2. On the folded edge, cut through the paper stopping about two inches from the other edge.



3. Unfold your paper, turning it as pictured below.



Tape your two shorter edges together to form a cylinder, as shown in the picture to your right.



4. Using your second piece of paper cut a handle and scripture strip.



5. On one of the strips cut write out Psalm 119:105  
Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet  
Tape or glue onto the top or bottom of the lantern.



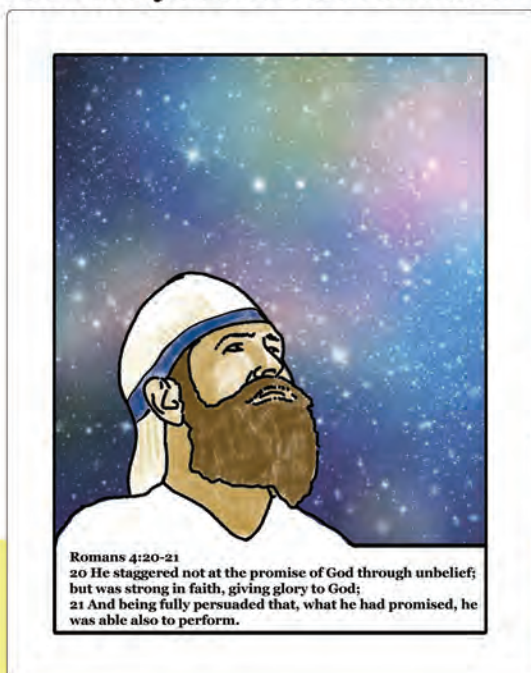
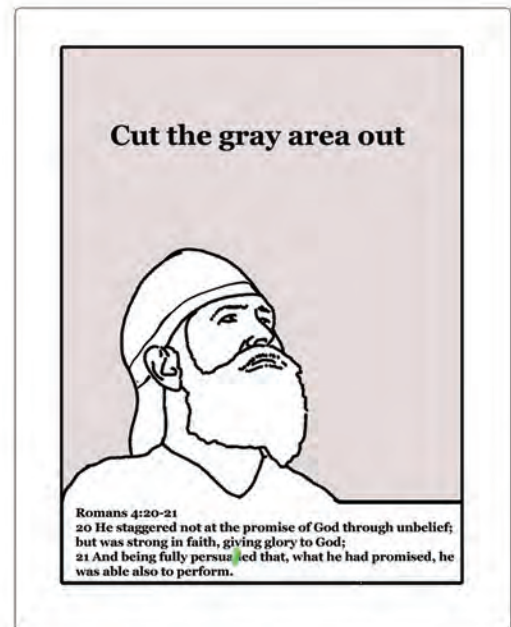


1. Print off Abraham graphic found at [suminskifamilybooks.com](http://suminskifamilybooks.com) (Essentials Craft PDF, or use QR code on this page), or draw your own version, then color Abraham in using colored pencils, crayons, markers or paint.

2. Cut out the gray area (the printable will not show the gray) leaving Abraham, the verse, and the white frame.

3. Using watercolor paints on an 8.5 x 11 sheet of watercolor paper, freely paint the colors of the night sky. (Note: If you wet your paper first, with a little bit of water your colors will spread and mingle nicely.)

4. When your painting is dry, take an old toothbrush and using white acrylic paint splatter the white paint to look like far away stars. When this is dry then place it and glue it behind your cut out of Abraham.

# God's Purpose and Man's Need

God's Plan to Repair what Adam Broke

You will need:

Printer

Cardstock 8.5 x 11

Yellow Watercolor paint

(Blow Dryer , to dry the watercolor, if time is of concern)

A set of colored pencils

Time to complete: 15-25 minutes

1. Print off the verse on 8.5 x 11 cardstock. You will find it at [suminskifamilybooks.com](http://suminskifamilybooks.com), or use the QR Code on this page to take you there.

2. Use yellow watercolor paint and paint around the words "the Father", "the Son", and "the Savior" to make it look like those letters are glowing. Let it dry completely.

3. Choose 3 sets of 2 colors of colored pencils, one should be a lighter color and one should be a darker color. You should have 6 colored pencils all together - three lighter colors and three darker colors. (See picture below for example.)

4. Starting with one of your lighter colors begin to lightly color in the letters, then add a bit more pressure as you go down the letter. Now take your darker color and starting at the bottom of the letter color with more pressure and lessen the pressure as you go up the letter.

## You will need:

**Cardboard or sturdy Posterboard**

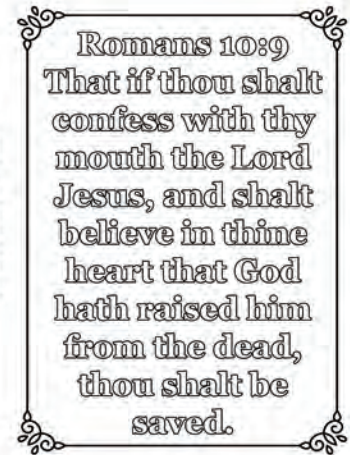
**Paper** for the verse, use white printing paper, or cardstock, 8.5 x 11 (Print off verse or write it out)

**Regular Glue**

**Items to decorate the frame around verse**

**Craft glue**

**Time: 20-30 minutes**



1. Find some cardboard or sturdy posterboard and cut a rectangle 12 inches x 10.5 inches.

2. On a 8.5x11- inch sheet of paper write out in your best handwriting Romans 10:9, or go to [suminskifamilybooks.com](http://suminskifamilybooks.com) website where you will find, under the Essentials for Life tab, a PDF. In this PDF you will find a printable copy of Romans 10:9. Print it off. We suggest printing on cardstock, but regular paper will also work.

3. Glue your print from step #1 onto your posterboard or cardboard.

4. Find objects on a scavenger hunt outside like sticks and small pebbles or find household items like fun pasta shapes or buttons. Colorful yarn would also be fun! Using craft glue, adhere the objects to the frame surrounding the verse. You could also punch holes at both top corners and put a yarn or string to help hang the beautiful framed verse.
